F1 LFN, 2 2004 (in this Bill referred to as "the Principal Act") is amended as set out in 2004 Principal Act 3 this Bill. 4 2. Substitute for the title to the Principal Act, a new title "Factories Amendment of the title to the 5 (Control and Regulation) Act". Act 6 3. Section 70 of the Principal Act is amended by substituting for Amendment of Section 70 expression, "N500 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding three 7 8 months" in line 2 and 3, the expression "N5000 or to imprisonment for a 9 term not exceeding one year". 10 4. Section 71 of the Principal Act is amended by substituting for Amendment of Section 71 11 the expression "N5000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding two years" in lines 4 and 5, the expression "N50, 000 or to imprisonment for a 12 13 term not exceeding seven years". 14 5. Section 72 of the Principal Act is amended by substituting for Amendment of Section 72 15 the expression, "N2, 000 or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twelve 16 months" in the last two lines, the expression, "N20, 000 or to imprisonment 17 for a term not exceeding three years". 18 6.
