AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROHIBITION OF KIDNAPPING, HOSTAGE TAKING, AND UNLAWFUL DETENTION OF PERSONS IN FEDERAL CAPITAL TERRITORY ABUJA AND FOR RELATED MATTERS, 2017

Sponsored by Hon. Samuel Ikon Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria-1. This Bill shall apply to the Federal Capital Territory, Abuja. Application of 2 2.-(1) A person commits an offence under this section, if he carries Kidnapping 3 or takes away another person or deprives another person of his or her right to 4 move to a place of his choice, either by force or deceit, and without the consent of the person or in the case of a minor or a mentally impaired person, without the consent of his or her guardian or without legal authority, with the intention of detaining or concealing such a person from having access to the 7 8 public 9 (2) A person that contravenes subsection (1) of this section is guilty of kidnapping and shall be sentence to life imprisonment or in case where 10 11 the victim dies, sentence to death. 12 3.-(1) A person commits an offence under this section, if he detains Hostage taking and threatens to kill or injure or continue to detain another person, in order to 13 14 compel a third person or a government organization to do or abstain from 15 doing any act as a condition for the release of the person detained. (2) A person that contravenes this section is guilty of Hostage 16 Taking and if convicted shall be sentence to life imprisonment or in case 17 where the victim dies, sentence to death. 18 4. Any person who receives, possesses, or disposes of any money 19 Ransom 20 or other property, or any portion thereof, which has at any time been

1 delivered as ransom or reward in connection with an offence under this act. 1891 knowing the same to be money or property which has been at any time 2. 3 delivered as such ransom or reward commits an offence and is liable on conviction to imprisonment for a term of not more than Five years or a fine not ، 4 5 exceeding Five Hundred Thousand Naira (N500,000) or to both. Application 6 5. This Bill does not apply to any person who steals, takes, entices 7 away, detains, conceals, or harbors any child, if that act is taken to protect the 8 child from danger of imminent harm.

- 9 6. Any person who puts forward himself overtly or covertly to
 10 another to be kidnapped for the purpose of exacting money, ransom or for any
 1.1 other reason shall on conviction be liable to a term of imprisonment of not more
 12 than ten years.
- 7. This Bill may be cited as the Federal Capital Territory, Kidnapping
 and Hostage Taking (Prohibition) Bill, 2017.
