AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONVOCATION OF A NATIONAL CONFERENCE FOR THE PEOPLE OF NIGERIA FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISCUSSING AND ADOPTING A NEW CONSTITUTION, TO BE SUBMITTED FOR CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL AT A REFERENDUM AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES CONNECTED THERETO

Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: Commencement 1 1. As from the commencement of this Act, the convocation of any 2 Conference, be it National, Constitutional, Sovereign or by whatever name 3 or designation it may be called shall be made by the President or any person having power or acting in that capacity in accordance with the provisions of 4 5 this Bill. б 2. Such a conference shall be held at an interval of not less than a Time for holding of a Conference 7 decade or at such other time and under such circumstances as the President 8 with 2/3 majority of the National 9 Assembly may consider it necessary or expedient to so do. 10 3.-(1) The participation of any person, individual, group or Participation of persons, individuals, groups etc at the 11 association at the Conference shall be based on election and nomination on Conference 12 the basis of all the identifiable Ethnic Nationalities in Nigeria. 13 (2) Each identified ethnic Nationality shall be represented at the 14 Conference by at least one person to be so nominated from the particular 15 ethnic Nationality. 16 (3) Without prejudice to the provisions of subsections (1) and (2) 17 herein of this Bill, the Federal Government shall have power to nominate

persons to participate at any Conference, having regard to equality of States,

	3	4(1) For the purpose of this Bill, there shall be six geo-political
	4	zones in Nigeria, namely North-central; North-East; North-West; South-East;
	5	South-South and South-West zones.
	6	(2) Each of the six geo-political zones shall consist of the States that
	7	fall under that head or categorization.
Establishment of zonal councils	8	5(1) There shall be established in each zone, a zonal Council.
	9	(2) Each zonal Council shall have a Chairman and two Members from
	10	each of the Senatorial Districts of States within the particular zone and shall
	11	serve as the rallying point for harnessing the aggregate views and pre-
	12	conference position of such zone.
	13	(3) Members of a zonal Council shall be appointed by the traditional
	14	council and the State Governor in equal number.
	15	(4) The Chairman of a zonal Council shall be elected by Members of
	16	that Council.
Meeting of zonal	17	(5) the inaugural meeting of the zonal council for the purpose of
	18	electing the Chairman of that Council shall be convened by the Governor of the
	19	State by the Attorney-general of the State that nominated the zonal council and
	20	the date, time and venue of such meeting shall be notified to every member of
	21	the council.
	22	6. A person shall cease to hold office as Chairman or member of zonal
	23	council if:
	24	(a) He becomes of unsound mind;
	25	(b) He becomes bankrupt or makes a composition with his creditors;
	26	(c) He is convicted of a criminal offence or of any offence involving
	27	fraud or dishonesty;
	28	(d) He is guilty of serious misconduct relation to his duties;
	29	(e) He accepts office as a public officer in the public service of the
	30	Federation or in the public service of a State.

Powers to organise and conduct the election

Qualifications

1	7. Subject to the provisions of this Act, a Zonal Council shall have
2	powers to organise and conduct the election of the persons who are to serve
3	as delegates to the national conference from that zone. For this purpose the
4	zonal council shall have power to employ its own machinery for organising
5	the election.
6	8(1) A person shall not be qualified to be elected as a delegate to
7	the National Conference if he is employed in the public service of the
8	Federation or in the public service of a State.
9	(2) A person shall not be quality to be elected as a delegate to the
10	National Conference, notwithstanding the fact that he is a member of a
11	Zonal Council.
12	(3) In the election of delegates to the National Conference, a Zonal
13	Council shall ensure that as far as the practicable, ethnic groups or
14	nationalities indigenous to the zone and the shades of political opinion in the
15	area for which it is established are fairly represented and further that the
16	delegates include persons who by reason of their academic backgrounds,
17	experience in or knowledge of the affairs of the country or membership of
18	important interest groups can contribute meaningfully to deliberations at the
19	National Conference.
20	(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of section (3) of this section, a
21	zonal council may co-opt any person as a delegate to represent the zone,
22	including a person from the zone, but the total number of delegates from any
23	zone shall not exceed that allocated to it under the provisions of this Bill.
24	(5) Subject to the provision of subsection (3) of this section,
25	delegates to the Conference shall be by nomination or election as the case
26	may be.
27	(6) a person shall not be elected or nominated as a delegate to the
28	national conference, or if elected or nominated shall cease to be a member if
29	any of the events mentioned in subsections (a)-(e) of section (6) of this Bill
30	(which would disqualify a chairman or member of a zonal Council) occurs

in relation to him.

	2	(7) Any vacancy occurring among the delegates to the National
	3	Conference shall be filled by an election conducted by the appropriate Zonal
	4	Council in accordance with the provisions of this Bill.
	5	9(1) There shall be for the purpose of this Bill a National Conference
	6	Committee which shall, subject to this Bill have full power to deliberate upon
	7	and produce a draft Constitution or amendment of same for the Federal
	8	Republic of Nigeria as well as other matters relating to the unity, welfare and
	9	good government of the country.
	10	(2) For the purpose of subsection 1 above, a draft new constitution
	11	prepared by a Committee and members of the presidential advisory committee
	12	on National Conference appointed for that purpose by the President shall be
	13	laid before the conference and form the basis of its deliberation and decision.
, - w	14	10. The outcome of a National Conference shall be subjected to a
	15	referendum and the outcome of the referendum shall be adopted by the
	16	National Assembly, subject to the procedure for passage of an ordinary Bill.
	17	11. The NASS shall conclude its deliberations on same within 4
	18	months and forward to President for assent within 2 months.
	19	12. Where same is not passed or assented to after the stipulated time, it
	20	will be deemed to have been passed or assented to.
nterpretation	21	13. In this Bill and except where the context otherwise requires:
	22	"National Conference" means body of persons established in accordance with
	23	the provisions of this Bill;
	24	"President" Means the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria;
	25	"Public Service of the Federation" or "public service of a State" has the
	26	meaning assigned to those expressions in the constitution of the Federal
	27	Republic of Nigeria, 1999;
	28	"Ethnic Nationality" means the people of Nigeria consisting of social groups,
	29	with self perpetuating biological group sharing the same culture, symbols
	30	language, value system, custom, normative behaviour and whose members are

1	anchored in a particular part of Nigeria homeland and/or safe heaven;	
2	"State" or "States" refers to a territory or territories described as such in part l	
3	of the First to schedule to the Constitution of the Federal republic of Nigeria,	
4	1999 and include the government in control of such territory or territories;	
5	"Zone" and cognate expression refer to any of the six groups of states	
6	mentioned in section 4 of this Bill.	
7	14. This Bill may be cited as the National Conference and Citation	
8	Referendum Bill and shall come into force on the date of its public in the	
9	Gazette.
