AN ACT TO AMEND THE EDUCATION TAX ACT CAP E4 LFN 2004 TO PROVIDE FOR THE UPWARD REVIEW OF PENALTIES FOR NON-COMPLIANCE AND FOR RELATED MATTERS, 2017

Sponsored by Hon. Odeneye Kehinde Olusegun Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria: 1. The Education Tax Act, Cap E4 Laws of the Federation of Amendment of 1 the Principal Act Nigeria 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Act") is hereby 2 amended as set out in this Bill. 3 2. Section 11(1) of the Principal Act is amended by replacing Amendment of 4 Section 11(1) existing paragraphs (a) and (b) and inserting new paragraph (c) as follows: 5 (a) For a first offence, to a minimum fine of N100,000.00 or 6 imprisonment for a term of three years; 7 (b) For a second and subsequent offence, to a minimum fine of 8 N200,000.00 or imprisonment for a term of five years or both such fine and 9 imprisonment; 10 (c) The fines stipulated under paragraphs (a) and (b) of this 11 subsection may be upwardly varied in the vent of special or extraordinary 12 circumstances, which may include the current value of the national 13 currency, the seriousness of the offence, the contrition or lack thereof of the 14 defendants, amongst other factors. 15 3. This Bill may be cited as the Education Tax Act (Amendment) Citation 16 Bill, 2017. 17 EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Education Tax Act to provide for the upward review of the penalties for non-compliance with the provisions of the Act.
