AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR FARMERS REGISTRATION ACT THAT WILL CREATE A DATABASE OF FARMERS IN NIGERIA AND FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: PART 1 - ESTABLISHMENT 1 1. There is hereby established a Farmers Registration Act to 2 provide a Data Base of Farmers in Nigeria that will enable Government give 3 incentives to farmers. 4 PART 2 - PURPOSE OF THE ACT 5 6 2. The purpose of this Act is to provide for: (a) A farm -business registration system designed to facilitate access to the programs of government by farm businesses; 8 9 (b) The creation of a data base that may be used: (i) By government departments to verify farm business eligibility 10 for programs of assistance; and 11 12 (ii) For the development of agricultural policy. (c) The fair and equitable funding of general farm organizations by 13 14 farm businesses; (d) To enable government deal with real farmers. 15 PART 3 - GENERAL FARM ORGANIZATION 16 17 3.-(1) To be considered a General Farm Organization for the purposes of this Act, the organization must have at least the percentage of 18 19 registered farm businesses as members as prescribed in the regulations, having geographic representation from across the province as prescribed by 20

	28	farm business may register with the Registrar on an annual basis in accordance

2	regulation, register with the Registrar on an annual basis in accordance with

16	the information referred to in subsection (4) to a general farm organization.

18	Registrar pursuant to this section, the Registrar or a person authorized by the

25	farm organization pursuant to this section, The Registrar, or a person

Composition of Appeal Committee	2	7(1) There shall be an Appeal Committee consisting of:

	19	PART 6 - APPLICATION OF FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT
	20	9(1) For greater certainty, the Freedom of Information Act applies to
	21	information submitted to the Registrar pursuant to section 8 of this Act.

	23	general farm organization pursuant to sub-section 8(4) of this Act shall be kept
	24	confidential and shall not be disclosed to any person, except as may be
	25	necessary for the performance of the general farm organization's duties under

7	this Act; Prescribing the criteria for a general farm organization;
8	(c) Prescribing any fees to be paid;

10	such matters or things as may be considered necessary for carrying out
11	effectively the intent and purpose of this Act.
12	(3). The regulatory exercise by the Minister shall be within the
13	meaning and context of the Regulations Act.
14	PART 9 - INTERPRETATION
15	12. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires:
16	(a) "Appeal Committee" means the Appeal Committee established
17	pursuant to this Act;
18	(b) "Department" means the Ministry of Agriculture;
19	(c) "Farmers" means all those who engages in all sorts of farming
20	including planting of crops, rearing animals and fishing etc. (d) "Minister"
21	means the Minister of Agriculture;
22	(e) "Registrar" means the Registrar of Farms appointed pursuant to
23	this Act.

25	13. This Bill may be cited as Farmers Registration Bill, 2017.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This bill seeks to professionalize fanning in Nigeria and diversify the economy with a view to boost food production and economic activities. The bill defines who is a Nigerian Farmer. It provides a means through which Nigerian Farmers are registered by the Ministry of Agriculture which will be useful for easier identification and for purposes of giving incentives to farmers.
