## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the University of Lagos Act Cap.U9 laws of the Federation of Nigeria by specifying the minimum qualification of the Chairman of the Governing Council, ownership of intellectual property and providing for pre-action notice to the University authority.
