

A BILL

AN ACT TO AMEND THE BAYERO UNIVERSITY ACT CAP. B5 LAWS OF THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA, 2004 TO SPECIFY THE MINIMUM QUALIFICATION THE CHAIRMAN OF THE GOVERNING COUNCIL, OWNERSHIP OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND TO PROVIDE FOR PRE-ACTION NOTICE TO THE UNIVERSITY AUTHORITY; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria-1. The Bayero University Act Cap. B5 Laws of the Federation of Amendment of Nigeria, 2004 (in this Bill referred to as "the Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill. 2. Section 5(a) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after Amendment of Section 5(a) the word, "Pro-Chancellor", the words, "who shall possess a minimum of a 5 university degree or its equivalent with cognate experience, integrity, vibrancy and must be healthy and fit to perform the function of a chairman;". 3. Section 10 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting a new Amendment of Section 10 9 sub section "(2A)"-"(2A) The University shall make Intellectual Property Governance 10 Codes that comply with international best practice to govern the ownership 11 of intellectual property within the university". 12 4. The Principal Act is amended by inserting a new section "19A"-13 "19A. Pre-Action Notice: 14 (1) An aggrieved staff or student shall not commence a suit in Court 15 against the University except the staff or student gives the University one 16 17 month written notice of intention to commence the suit. 18 (2) The written notice of under subsection (1) of this section shall

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Bayero University Act Cap. B5 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to specify the minimum qualification of the Chairman of the Governing Council, ownership of intellectual property and to provide for pre-action notice to the University authority from an aggrieved staff or student.
