

Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria-1. The Nigerian Dock Labour Act, Cap. 103, Laws of the Amendment of 1 Cap. 100 LFN, 2004 Federation of Nigeria, 2004 (in this Bill referred to as "the Principal Act") is 2 amended as set out in this Bill. 2. Section 3 (1) of the Principal Act is amended-Amendment of Section 3 (1) (a) in subsection (d), the words, "two representatives", for the 5 words, "one representative"; and (b) in subsection (h), the words, "two representatives", for the 7 words, "one representative". 8 3. Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by substituting in-Amendment of Section 4 (a) subsection (1) the words, "three years", for the words, "four 10 years"; and 11 (b) by deleting the words, "further term of three years" and 12 inserting "another term of two years". 13 Amendment of 4. Section 5 (1) of the Principal Act is amended in subsection (a) 14 Section 5 (1) by adding "incapable of carrying out his duties" after the word, "or". 15 5.
