AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A CENTRE FOR SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH INTO PLANT MEDICINE AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Commencement ENACTED by National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria: 1.-(1) There is established a Centre to be known as the Centre for Establishment of the Centre Scientific Research into Plant Medicine (herein after called "the Centre"). 2 (2) The Centre shall be body Corporate with perpetual succession 3 and, a common seal, and may sue and be sued in its Corporate name. 4 2.-(1) There is established for the Centre, a governing body (herein Establishment of the Council called "the Council"). 6 (2) Membership of the Council shall consist of: 7 (a) a Chairman, who shall be a person with a recognized 8 qualification in Plant Medicine or a related subject, and to be appointed by the Minister; 10 (b) a representatives of the National Universities Commission; 11 (c) a representative of the Deans of Universities conducting 12 research in Plant Medicine; 13 (d) a representative of the Deans of Faculty of Pharmaceutical 14 Studies in the Nigerian Universities 15 (e) the Chief Medical Officer of the Centre; 16 (f) a representative of the Pharmaceutical Council of Nigeria; 17 (g) two persons with special interest in Plant Medicine 18 (3) Ex-officio Member other than the Chairman shall be appointed 19 by the Minister in consultation with the relevant bodies; 20.

1	alienate or dispose of that property and enter into any other transaction.

3	Centre, the property may be acquired for the Centre.
4	(3) A person shall not charge or dispose of land or buildings of the
5	Centre without the consent in writing of the Council, which may be signified
6	by the signature of the Chairman or of any other person duly authorised by
7	
8	the Council to act in that behalf.
9	16. The Minister may make Regulation on the recommendations Regulations of the Council
