Section 27, sub-section (1), in the last paragraph of the Principal Amendment of 4 section 27 (1) Act is hereby amended as follows: 5 (a) by deleting the words "of one thousand" after the word "fine" 6 and substitute same with the words, "not exceeding Five Hundred Million." 7 (b) By deleting the word, "of two" after the word "term" and 8 substitute same with the words, "not exceeding five." 9 3. This Bill may be cited as the Firearms (Amendment) Bill, 2017. Citation 10 EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM This Bill seeks to review and increase the penalty for contravention of the offence of unlawful possession of and dealing in firearms and ammunitions including muzzle-loading firearms. This punitive measure will to an extent assist in the administration of criminal justice system in Nigeria.
