1	1. As from the commencement of this Bill every hospital in	Right to treatment
2	Nigeria whether public or private shall accept or receive for immediate and	
3	adequate treatment with or without police clearance any person with a	
4	gunshot wounds.	
5	2. Every person including security agents shall render every	Duty to assist
6	possible assistance to any person with gunshot wounds and ensure that the	
7	person is taken to the nearest hospital for immediate treatment.	
8	3. Accordingly:	Preservation of fundamental right of a victim
9	(i) no person with gunshot wound shall be refused immediate and	
10	adequate treatment by any hospital in Nigeria whether or not initial	
11	monetary deposit is paid.;	
12	(ii) no person with a bullet wound shall be subjected to inhuman	
13	and degrading treatment or torture by any person or authority including the	
14	police or other security agencies.	
15	4. It shall be the duty of any hospital that receives any person with	Notification to Police
16	a gunshot wound to report the fact to the nearest police station within two (2)	
17	hours of commencement of treatment.	
18	5. Upon receipt of the aforesaid report, the police shall	Police to investigate
19	immediately commence investigation with a view to determining the	
20	circumstances under which the person was shot.
