AN ACT TO AMEND THE FEDERAL CHARACTER COMMISSION ACT, CAP F7, LFN 2004 TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FEDERAL CHARACTER TRIBUNAL FOR THE PROSECUTION OF VIOLATIONS OF THE FEDERAL CHARACTER ACT AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Federal Character Act, Cap. F7, Laws of the Federation of 1 Nigeria, 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Act"). 2 2. The Principal Act is amended by inserting a new Section 1SA to 3 read as follows: 4. "Establishment of the Federal Character Commission Tribunal. 5 15A,-(1) There shall be established a tribunal to be known as 6 Federal Character Commission Tribunal which shall consist of a Chairman 7 8 and two other persons. (2) The Chairman shall be a person who has held or is qualified to 9 hold office as a Judge of a superior court of record in Nigeria and shall 10 receive such remuneration as may be prescribed by law. 11 (3) The Chairman and members of the Federal Character Tribunal 12 shall be appointed by the President in accordance with the recommendation 13 14 of the National Judicial Council. (4) The National Assembly may by law confer on the Federal 15 Character Tribunal such additional powers as may appear to it to be 16 necessary to enable it more effectively to discharge the functions conferred 17 on it in this Schedule. 18
