AN ACT TO ESTABLISH FEDERAL COLLEGE OF EDUCATION AKWETE, ABIA STATE, TO PROVIDE FULL-TIME COURSES TEACHING, INSTRUCTION AND TRAINING IN TECHNOLOGY, APPLIED SCIENCE, ARTS, SOCIAL SCIENCES, HUMANITIES AND MANAGEMENT AND FOR RELATED MATTERS, 2017

- 2. Where a vacancy occurs in respect of the membership specified in section 3, it shall be filled by the appointment of a successor to hold office for the reminder of the term of office of his predecessor in office and such successor shall represent the same interest as his predecessor.
- 3. The council may act notwithstanding any vacancy in its membership or any defect in the appointment of a member or the absence of a member.

## **Proceedings**

- 4.-(1) The Council shall meet for the conduct of business at such times, places and on such days as the chairman may appoint but shall meet not less than once every four months.
- (3) The chairman may at any time and shall, at the request in writing of not less than six members, convene a meeting of the council.

i,	(4) Where the council desires to obtain the advice of any person on
2	any particular matter, the council may co-opt persons who are not members of
3	the council but persons co-opted shall not be entitled to vote at a meeting of the
4	council.
5	(5) The Quorum of the Council shall be one half of the total members
6	of the Council, at least one of whom shall be a member appointed by the
7	President.
8	(6) Decisions of the Council shall be made on approval by a simple
9	majority of members.
10	Miscellaneous
11	5(1) The fixing of the seal of the college shall be authenticated by the
12	signature of the chairman, Provost and of some other members of the Council
13	authorized generally or specially by the Council to act for that purpose.
14	(2) Any contract or instrument which, if made or executed by a person
15	other than a body corporate would not be required to be under seal may be made
16	executed on behalf of the college by any person generally or specially
17	authorized to act for that purpose by the council.
18	(3) Any document purporting to be duly executed under the seal of the
19	College shall be received in evidence and shall, unless the contrary is proved
20	be presumed to be so executed.

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to establish the Federal College of Education, Akwete Abia State, as institution to offer full-time courses leading to the awards of National Certificates of Education, Diplomas etc.
