	16	Proceedings of the Board
	17	(1) Subject to this bill and clause 28 of the Interpretation of this Bill,
	18	the Board may make standing orders regulating its proceedings or those of any
	19	of its committee.
	20	(2) The quorum of the Board shall be the Chairman or the person
	21	presiding at the meeting, Director General or one Executive Director and one
	22	third of other members of the Board. The quorum of any Committee of the
	23	Commission shall be as determined by the Board.
	24	(3) The Board shall meet whenever it is summoned by the Chairman
	25	and if the Chairman is required to do so by notice given to him by not less than 4
	26	other members, he shall summon a meeting of the Board to be held within 14
	27	days from the date on which the notice is given.
	28	(4) At any meeting of the Board the Chairman shall preside but where

12	authenticated by the signatures of the Chairman or any other member of the
13	Board generally or specifically authorised by the Board to act for the
14	purpose and the Director General.
15	(2) A document purporting to be a document duly executed under
16	the seal of the Commission shall be received in evidence and shall, unless
17	and until the contrary is proved, be presumed to be so executed.
18	(3) The validity of any proceedings of the Board or of a committee
19	shall not be adversely affected by-
20	(a) a vacancy in the membership of the Board or committee;
21	(b) a defect in the appointment of a member of the Board or
22	committee; or
23	(c) Reason that a person not entitled to do so took part in the
24	proceedings of the Board or committee.
