AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF FINANCIAL CONTROL DEPARTMENT (FCD) IN THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT, FOR THE PURPOSE OF MONITORING FINANCES OF ALL FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND MINISTRIES, EXTRA-MINISTERIAL DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES AND FOR RELATED MATTERS, 2017.

Sponsored by Hon, Johnson Egwakhide Oghuma Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. There is established the Financial Control Department in the Establishment of the humerai Control office of the President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria (in this Bill 2 Department 3 referred to as the "Department") as set out in this Bill. The objectives of the Department shall be: 4 the Department (a) To deepen accountability, transparency in the finances of government ministries, extra ministerial departments and agencies; 6 (b) To enforce internal control processes within Federal 7 Government Revenue Generating Agencies to ensure compliance with the 8 financial Laws, regulations, policies and procedures: 9 (c) To detect and track down unremitted funds domicile in the 10 various Federal Government Ministerial and Extra-Ministerial 11 Departments/Agencies and ensure such funds are remitted forthwith to the 12 13 Federation Government: (d) To reconcile all bank accounts and statements of MDAs every 14 15 month, and reports made to the President; and (e) To carryout detailed investigation on any grey areas brought 16 before it by any government ministry, extra-ministerial 17 departments/agencies to unravel the correct position and make 18
