1 (v) Executive Secretary, FCDA. 2 (c) The Director General of the Service IS a member/Secretary of the 3 Board. 4 (2) The supplementary provisions contained in the first schedule to 5 this Bill shall have effect with respect to the proceedings of the Board and other 6 matters. 7 3.-(1) The Chairman and Members of the Board, mentioned under Tenure of some members of the Board Clause 2 (1) (b) (iv) shall hold office for the term of three years and renewable, 8 9 subject to satisfactory performance, for further term of three years and no 10 more. Cap. 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(5) The validity of any proceeding of the Board or of a committee shall not be adversely affected by any vacancy in the membership of the Board or Committee or by any defect in the appointment of a member of the Board or Committee or by reason that a person not entitled to take part in the proceedings of the Board or the Committee took part.
