BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1 1. The principal Act is hereby amended III Section II by inserting Amendment of Section II 2 a new subsection (3) as follows: "Provided that the power shall only be exercised if the person sought to be 3 appointed is qualified to hold the substantive office". 4 The principal Act is hereby amended by adding a new 5 Amendment of Section II subsection (4) as follows: 6 "No law shall enable a person "to act" beyond six months III any single 7 instance". 8 9 3. The principal Act is hereby amended by adding the definition of Amendment of Section 18(1) child after the definition of "act" but before "chief as follows: 10 "Child" has the meaning ascribed to it by the Child Rights Act 2003, and 11 adding the definition of youth immediately after "year" 12 "Youth" means a person who is eighteen years and above but below (50) 13 14 years. EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM This Act amends the Interpretation Act, 2004 by among other things,

providing that for any person to be qualified to "act" in any office, the person must be qualified to hold the substantive position and such an acting

position cannot be beyond six months, Child and Youth are defined.
