A medical practitioner shall maintain a Professional Liability 1 Insurance Insurance cover against damages or injury attributable to his negligence, 2 professional malpractice, deviation from standard of medical practice or the 3 negligent act or omission of his employees. 4 17. A person or his/her legal guardians shall be entitled to 5 Compensation compensation from a medical practitioner when his health situation worsens or 6 death occurs to his/her person due to a mistake or negligence on the part of the 7 medical practitioner or where the medical practitioner deviates from the 8 standard medical practice and it results to serious injury or complication or 9 death to the person's health. 10 18. In a civil action for professional negligence, personal injury or 11 wrongful death against a medical practitioner, a person shall establish that the 12 medical practitioner's negligence, deviation from standard procedure, 13 performance or a wrong procedure or improper treatment resulted in the 14 alleged injury or death. 15 19. A medical practitioner shall be liable for the negligent acts of his Liability for 16 employee's employee if the employee was acting within the scope of his employment when negligence 17 the negligent act or omission occurred. 18 4. Section 21 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the Interpretation 19 following new definitions: 20 "medical practitioner" shall for the purpose of sections 15 to 19 of this Act 21 include; a health facility, hospital, clinic, employees of the health facility, 22 nurses, midwives, caregivers and any other personnel employed by the medical 23 practitioner, health facility, clinic or hospital whether privately or public 24 owned or otherwise; 25 "legal guardians" means any person standing in the position of parents, spouse, 26 relation, or legal representative to a person undergoing treatment by a medical 27 28 practitioner; "standard of medical practice" means acceptable standard of medical 29

procedure and course of treatment an average medical practitioner is expected

- to follow in the course of treatment for an ailment, disorder, disease or infection including the state of the course of medical treatment, surgical operation or alternative course of treatment, as well as the risks and benefits of that course of treatment.

  - The Act may be cited as the Medical and Dental Practitioners Citation (Amended) Act 2015.

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to strengthen the security of human life by providing for compensation for injuries or death suffered as a result of a medical practitioner's or medical facilities' negligence, which compensation shall be made out of the medical practitioner's Insurance Cover.
