## **FOR**

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR COMPULSORY COMPENSATION OF VICTIMS OF ROAD ACCIDENT BY COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE DRIVERS OR/MOTOR VEHICLE OWNERS AND TO ESTABLISH THE ROAD ACCIDENT VICTIMS COMPENSATION DEPARTMENT UNDER THE FEDERAL ROAD SAFETY COMMISSION AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

	BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal
	Republic of Nigeria as follows:
1	1. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any Act
2	or in any other enactment or Law, the provisions of this Act shall apply to all
3	commercial motor vehicle drivers and owners engage in the business of
4	conveying persons and all kinds of goods from one part of Nigeria to
5	another.
6	2. A person using a motor vehicle for commercial purposes
7	(hereinafter called "the driver") and the owner of the vehicle must ensure
8	that the motor vehicle is insured in accordance with the Insurance Act Cap I
9	Laws of the Federation 2004.
10	3(1) The driver of the motor vehicle shall be a fit and proper
11	person with no physical impairment and mentally fit to drive a motor
12	vehicle.
13	(2) driver has a duty to ensure that the motor vehicle is in proper
14	condition in accordance with the Road Traffic Act.
15	(3) the driver shall use the motor vehicle in a proper manner to
16	avoid dangerous driving.
17	(4) The driver shall obey the speed limits prescribed under the

Road Traffic Act.

1	(5) the driver shall ensure that in the use of the motor vehicle, no
2	bodily damage is done to any person.
3	(6) it shall be the duty and responsibility of any driver driving any
4	motor Vehicle on Nigerian roads to ensure the safety of other road users
5	4(1) A Commercial motor vehicle driver using a motor vehicle in
6	which bodily damage is done to a person shall be guilty of an offence of causing
7	bodily damage and liable to compensate the victim.
8	(2) the driver shall compensate the victim for bodily damage caused
9	him in a road accident in which the vehicle was involved.
10	(3) the driver of the motor vehicle shall compensate the victim for
11	bodily damage caused him in a road accident in which the vehicle was involved
12	if the accident occurred in Nigeria.
13	5. In determining whether bodily harm has been done to a victim of
14	road accident, the liability of a driver using a motor vehicle in which bodily
15	damage is done to a person is absolute and it is immaterial whether or not there
16	was fault on the part of the driver.
17	6. Where the motor vehicle was used with the permission of the
18	owner or possessor, liability will also be incurred by the person who permitted
19	its use.
20	7. In the case of a road accident in which several vehicles were
21	involved, each driver found guilty will incur the liability for bodily harm
22	caused to the following:
23	(a) a person travelling in his (guilty driver) motor vehicle;
24	(b) a person travelling in other vehicle; and
25	(c) any other pedestrians outside the motor vehicle.
26	8(1) Where the person is injured outside the motor vehicle in a road
27	accident in which several motor vehicles were involved, the drivers will be
28	jointly and severally liable towards him, amongst each other, they will bear the
29	liability in equal shares.
30	(2) for the purpose of distributing the liability amongst the drivers

under this section, a motor vehicle is deemed to be involved in a road accident if at the time of the accident there was contact between it and any other vehicle or between it and the injured person.

9. In the case of a road accident in which several vehicles were

- 9. In the case of a road accident in which several vehicles were involved, and the victims are all in the vehicles each driver found guilty will incur the liability for bodily harm caused to the person(s) in any of the vehicles provided that where there is no admission of guilt from all or any of the drivers, the Court shall decide on the guilt of the driver(s).
- 10. Compensation to the victim shall be paid in monetary terms and in assessing compensation, calculation is made in respect of loss of earnings and loss of earning capacity. The amount to be paid as compensation shall be the actual earnings of the injured person for the first five years.

## 11. The compensation shall include:

- (1) expenses for the purpose of recovery, including hospitalisation fees incurred by the victim and the properties of the victim destroyed as a result of the accident;
- (2) where there is a dispute as to amount of compensation, adequate weekly payments shall be made pending the final determination of the matter;
- (3) the weekly payments for the victim shall include his welfare costs and upkeep or the upkeep of his immediate family members who depend on him. Such up keep costs will be determined having considered the income of the injured prior to the road accident provided that where the income exceeded the maximum cost, only the maximum income will be taken into account.
- 12. In the event that there is loss of life in any accident, the driver or drivers who drove the motor vehicle or motor vehicles or the owner who authorised the driving of the motor vehicle(s) shall pay the compensation in (9) and (10) above as the case may be to the named beneficiary for a period

2	13. The compensation referred to in this Act shall be tax free
3	14. A person who is entitled to receive compensation either as an
4	injured victim or as a beneficiary of a late victim shall have a right to lodge a
5	written complaint to the Road Accident Victims Compensation Department
6	within 7 days of the occurrence of the accident or if not immediately fit as a
7	result of the injuries and illness caused by the accident, within 7 days of he
8	becoming healthy and fit again stating the details of his compensation.
9	15(1) Upon receipt of such complaint, the Compensation
10	department shall within 3 days write to the driver or the owner of the motor
11	vehicle concerned informing him of the compensation due to the victim and
12	inviting a response to be made by the driver within a period of 7 days.
13	(2) the Compensation department shall also convene a meeting
14	inviting the driver or/and the owner and the victim with a view to concluding
15	the compensation payment due to the victim.
16	(3) the compensation shall be paid directly to the victim(s) and
17	evidence of payment shall be lodged with the Compensation department within
18	7 days of such payment.
19	(4) where the Compensation department is unable to conclude the
20	compensation payment due to the victim or the beneficiary of a deceased
21	victim and in the opinion of the Compensation department, the victim is
22	entitled to compensation, the victim or the beneficiary is entitled to institute an
23	action in a Court for the purpose of enforcing his right to compensation.
24	(5) the victim is entitled to institute an action on his behalf or through
25	the Compensation department for enforcing his right to compensation within
26	7days after the Compensation department has concluded negotiation between
27	the parties and no agreement reached.

(6) the Court before which an action is instituted is entitled to make a decision on such action within 21 days of the institution of the action. The amount decided by the Court will cover litigation expenses of the victim and

I	the amount payable will attract an additional 10% from the date of the
2	decision until the date on which payment is made
3	(7) the Court's decision in the action for payment will not constitute
4	a bar for action in respect of a claim for bodily injury
5	(8) where the user of motor vehicle is found guilty of causing
6	bodily injury, he is guilty of an offence and in addition to payment of
7	compensation liable to three months imprisonment or fine of N1 million.
8	15. The following victims will not be entitled to compensation
9	under this law:
10	(1) a person who intentionally caused the road accident;
11	(2) a person who was driving the motor vehicle in contravention of
12	the Road Traffic Law; or who was using the motor vehicle knowing that it
13	was being so driven;
14	(3) a person who was driving the motor vehicle without having
15	license to drive it;
16	(4) a person who was using or was helped by the motor vehicle to
17	commit felony;
18	(5) a person who was driving the motor vehicle without insurance
19	in accordance with the Insurance Act;
20	(6) a person whose insurance did not cover the use for which the
21	motor vehicle was employed;
22	(7) an owner of a motor vehicle who allowed another to use the
23	motor vehicle while he held no insurance in accordance with the Insurance
24	Act, and who was injured in a road accident which occurred while driving
25	whether he was in the motor vehicle or outside will not be entitled to claim
26	under this Act. However, a person who could not have reasonably known
27	that the motor vehicle is not covered by insurance will be entitled to claim
28	compensation from either the driver or the owner or claim jointly against the
29	driver and the owner. Also dependants of the victim shall be entitled to clain

1 **16.** The compensation referred to under this Act shall be in monetary 2 form and shall be personal to the victim or the beneficiary in the event of loss of life. 3 17. The compensation referred to under this Act shall be without 4 5 prejudice to the right of a third party under the Motor Vehicle (Third Party) 6 Insurance Act. 18. With regard to session 29 of this Act, where the claim under the 7 8 driver or owner's insurance policy is limited that it cannot cover a victims cost 9 of repairs of his car and medical expense, the driver and owner shall jointly and 10 severally bear the outstanding claim after the insurer has performed its 11 obligations under the Act. 19. For the purpose of giving effect to the provisions of this Act, there 12 shall be established a body to be known as the Road Accident Victims 13 Compensation Department under the Federal Road Safety Commission 14 Safety Commission 15 (referred to in this Act as "the Department"). 16 20. The Department shall for all intent and purposes be a department 17 with the Federal Road Safety Commission and shall be under the control and 18 directives of the Chairman of the Commission. 19 21. 15	25(1) A Staff of the Department who is directly or indirectly in	
16	any compensation matter handled by the Department shall disclose such	
17	interest immediately becoming aware of its existence.	
18	(2) Such a Staff shall not participate or continue to participate in	
19	any deliberation or decision of the Department with regard to the subject	
20	matter in respect of which his interest is so disclosed.

22	"bodily damage" means death, illness, injury or a physical, mental or	
23	intellectual defect on a person;	
24	"department" means the board in relation to the Commission;	
25	"commission" means the Federal Road Safety Commission established	
26	under Federal Road Safety Commission Act;	
27	"court" means the Magistrate or High Court;	
28	"dependants" means a child or blood relation of the victim;	
29	"motor vehicle" is any Commercial vehicle propelled by mechanical power	
30	over land and its main objective is to be used for land transportation	

1 including train, tractor or any mobile vehicle capable of moving by mechanical 2 power on a road, a towed motor vehicle supported by a motor vehicle. It is a 3 registered motor vehicle or a motor vehicle which need to have been registered 4 in Nigeria according to the Motor vehicle Licensing Registration Act or a 5 motor vehicle whose owner is a Nigerian; 6 "road accident" is an occurrence in which bodily damage is caused to a person 7 as a result of the use of a motor vehicle: 8 "use of motor vehicle" is the driving of a Commercial motor vehicle, entering 9 or exiting thereof, parking, pushing or towing thereof, road side treatment or 10 road side repair including the rolling down or turning over of the motor vehicle, 11 disengagement or falling of a part of the motor vehicle or its cargo while in 12 transit as well as disengagement or falling of from a standstill or parked motor 13 vehicle; 14 "victim" means a person to whom bodily damage has been caused in a road 15 accident.
