### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend Compulsory, Free Universal Basic Education Act, Act No. 66 of 2004, by giving all children access to free primary and secondary education in order to reduce the percentage of out of school record in Nigeria, reducing the 50% counterpart funding by States for infrastructure and equipment of the schools as a condition for accessing the Education Funds Grant to 15% and increasing the statutory allocation for basic education from 2% to 3%.
