	ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of	
	Nigeria as follows:	
1	1(1) As from the Commencement of this Act all Secondary	Vocational Training
2	Schools in Nigeria shall include the teaching of Vocational Training as part	
3	of the curriculum.	
4	(2) It is hereby accordingly declared that it shall be the policy of	
5	Government to ensure that Vocational Training, be taught in all Secondary	
6	Schools in Nigeria as from the commencement of this Bill. Herein referred	
7	to as the "Principal Act".	
8	2(1) Every Secondary School in Nigeria that fails or refuses to	Offences and Penalties
9	include the teaching of Vocational Training, in its Syllabuses commits an	
10	offence and is liable on conviction to a fine of not less than One Million	
11	Naira (N1,000,000.00) or may have its operating license revoked.	
12	(2) Where a Secondary School commits an offense under this Bill,	
13	any Officer or Agent of the School who directed, authorized, assented to or	
14	acquiesced or participated in the commission of the offense is a party to and	
5	is liable on conviction to a fine not less than Five Hundred Thousand Naira	
6	(N500,000.00), or to imprisonment for a term of Twelve Months.

Interpretation

- 4. In this Bill unless the context otherwise requires:
- "Secondary School" means Public and Private (Government Approved Private
- 3 Schools) in Nigeria;
- 4 "Vocational Training" means Education that prepares people for specific
- 5 trades, crafts and careers at various levels from a trade, a craft, technician
- 6 which emphasizes skills and knowledge required for a particular job function
- 7 (such as typing or data entry) or a trade (such as carpentry or welding etc)
- designed to equip students with the necessary knowledge and skills, to be self-
- dependant and self-empowerment after Secondary (if need be) to reduce the
- 10 rising phenomena of unemployment and joblessness in Nigeria.

5. This Bill may be cited as Vocational Training (Inclusion in Secondary Schools Syllabuses) Bill, 2015.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill Seeks to Provide for the Inclusion and Teaching of Vocational Training as a Course in the Syllabuses of all Secondary Schools in Nigeria; To Promote the Development, to Train Self Dependant and Self Empowered Skilled Nigerian Youth after leaving Secondary School to reduce the problem of unemployment and for best International Practice.

This Bill also makes it an Offence for any Secondary School in Nigeria not to include the Teaching of Vocational Training in the Syllabuses of its School.
