

AN ACT TO PRESCRIBE WOMEN QUOTAS FOR ELECTIONS INTO THE SENATE,
HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, STATE HOUSES OF ASSEMBLY AND AREA
COUNCILS OF FCT TO SUPPORT AND ENHANCE WOMEN PARTICIPATION AND
REPRESENTATION IN CERTAIN ELECTIVE OFFICES AND FOR RELATED
MATTERS

Sponsored by Hon. Sadiq Ibrahim Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria: 1 1. All political parties who wish to present candidates for election Presentation of candidates for 2 into the Senate, House of Representatives, State Houses of Assembly and Election 3 Area Council of the FCT shall ensure compliance with the provisions of this 4 Bill. 5 2.-(1) In conducting primaries for National Assembly elections, all Elections into the National 6 political parties shall comply with the provisions of this bill before Assembly 7 submitting their lists of candidates to the Independent National Electoral 8 Commission. 9 (2) In general elections to the Senate, all political parties shall 10 ensure that at least one candidate from the three senatorial zones of the State 11 is a woman. 12 (3) In general elections to the House of Representatives, all 13 political parties shall ensure that at least one-third of the total number of 14 candidates from all the Federal constituencies of the State are women. 15 Provided that in complying with the provisions of sub Sections (2) 16 and (3) of this Section, the nomination of women candidates shall be rotated amongst the various senatorial zones and federal constituencies of the 17 18 respective state in a manner as may be prescribed by the Independent

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to provide for women participation in Elections in accordance with the obligations incumbent upon Nigeria as a State Party and in an effort to implement certain provisions of the African Union's Charter on Human and Peoples Rights particularly Article 9 of the Protocol to the African Charter on Human and Peoples' Rights on the Rights of Women in Africa which obligates State Parties to take specific positive action to promote participative governance and the equal participation of women in the political life of their countries through affirmative action, enabling national legislation and other measures to ensure amongst other things, that women are represented equally at all levels with men in all electoral processes; this Bill seeks to prescribe women quotas for elections into the Senate, House of Representatives, State Houses of Assembly and Area Council Elections in FCT in order to support and enhance women participation and representation in certain elective offices.
