## FOR

AN ACT TO AMEND THE FEDERAL HIGHWAYS ACT CAP F13 LAWS OF FEDERATION OF NIGERIA 2004 TO MAKE DRIVING AGAINST TRAFFIC OR ONE WAY AN OFFENCE AND FOR CONNECTED MATTERS THEREWITH

Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the NATIONAL Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Federal Highways Act Cap F13 LFN 2004 (hereinafter Amendment of the Principal Act called "The Principal Act") is hereby amended by inserting three new sections/clauses, namely sections 20A, 20B and 20C of this Amendment Bill immediately after the existing section 20 of the Principal Act and before the heading "miscellaneous and Supplemental" thus: "Section 20A, DRIVING AGAINST TRAFFIC As from the date of the Commencement of this Act, any person who on a Federal Highway: (a) drives against normal cause of traffic; (b) drives in an opposite direction of a prescribed one way road; or (c) drives facing vehicles coming on an opposite direction by driving on their lanes whilst not overtaking, has committed an offence under this Act and in the case of a first offender,

"Section 20B, OBSTRUCTIONS ON THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY

shall have his vehicle impounded, be subject to psychiatric examination in a

Federal Medical Institution, his Drivers Licence shall be seized and shall be

mandated to pay N50,000.00 to the National Treasury before release of the

court and upon conviction liable to three (3) months imprisonment and or a
