1	1. The Medical Therapy Rehabilitation Registration Etc Act CAP	Amendment of Section 16 of the Principal Act
2	M9 LFN referred to as the principal Act is amended as set out below;	
3	2. Section 16 of the principal Act is amended by deleting the words	
4	one hundred naira and two hundred naira inserting the words Ten thousand	
5	Naira and Twenty Thousand Naira respectively to read as follows:	
6	"Any person not being registered on the register established under section 7	
7	of this Act who holds himself out to be registered or uses any name title,	
8	description or symbol calculated to lead any person to infer that he is so

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Medical Rehabilitation Therapist Registration Etc Act by increasing the amount to be paid as fine for the commission of an offence slated in the Principal Act.
