## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to harmonise the functions of National Orientation Agency and National Institute for Cultural Orientation to, among other things, empower the National Institute for Cultural Orientation to enlighten the general public on Federal Government policies and programmes, and serve as a focus for orientation in cultural maters for Nigerian policy makers.
