## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

(This memorandum does not form part of the above Act, but is intended to explain its purport)

This Bill seeks to amend the Weights and Measures Act (Cap W3 LFN 2004, Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004) to among other things, review upwards the fines stipulated for offences under the Act.
