This Bill may be cited as the Association of National Citation 11 accountants of Nigeria (Amendment) Bill, 2015. 12 EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM This Bill seeks to amend the Association of National Accountants of Nigeria Act Cap. A26 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to increase the fines

and to make appeal lie from the Disciplinary Tribunal to the High Court.
