Section 9 (2)

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria-

1. The Currency Conversion (Freezing Orders) Act Cap. C43
CAP. C43 LFN.
2 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 (in this Bill referred to as the
"Principal Act') is amended as set out in this Bill.

- 2. Section 9 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by substitution for Section 9 (1) the phrase "the President may in his discretion direct that" in line 2, the phrase, "the judge of a high court may after hearing the parties direct that".
  - 3. Section 9 (2) of the Principal Act is deleted.
- 4. This Bill may be cited as the Currency Conversion (Freezing Citation Orders) (Amendment) Bill, 2015.

### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Currency Conversion (Freezing Orders) Act Cap. C43 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to give discretionary powers to the Judge of a High Court, to order forfeiture of assets of affected person.
