PENALTIES AND TO MAKE BETTER PROVISIONS FOR ITS IMPLEMENTATION

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Price Control Act, prescribe stiffer penalties and to make better provisions for its implementation.
