] Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria and by the Authority of Same as follows-1 1. Amendment of the Nigerian Legion Act, Cap. 37 of 1988 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Act is amended as set out in this Act. 2 3 2. Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting new 4 paragraphs (g), (h), and (i) and re-arrange accordingly-5 (g) Secure pensions, allowances, grants and war gratuities for military veterans, their dependents and widows and dependents of deceased 6 7 military veterans; 8 (h) Establish, organize and regulate the activities of zonal, state and local government branches of the Legion at convenient centres throughout 10 the country; 11 (i) Raise and mobilize funds to assist the aged, sick, needy, 12 disabled, infirm and destitute military veterans; and 13 (g) Perform any other functions conferred on it by this Act or that 14 are ancillary to the objectives of the Legion. 15 3. Part IV of the Principal Act is amended in the Schedule Section 16 4 (4) National Council of the Legion by deleting sub-section (1 (a) and (b) and insert a new Sub-Section 1, and Sub-section 4 and re-arrange 17 18 accordingly-
