AN ACT TO AMEND THE FEDERAL CAPITAL TERRITORY STATUTORY APPROPRIATION ACT 2015 AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Commencement

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows:

1. The Federal Capital Territory Statutory Appropriation Act, 2015 is amended by substituting the Long Title with the following: 2 3 "A BILL 4 FOR AN ACT TO AUTHORISE THE ISSUE FROM THE FEDERAL CAPITAL 5 TERRITORY ADMINISTRATION STATUTORY REVENUE FUND OF THE 6 FEDERAL CAPITAL TERRITORY ADMINISTRATION ACCOUNT THE TOTAL 7 SUM OF N193,864,591,470 (ONE HUNDRED AND NINETY THREE BILLION, 8 9 EIGHT HUNDRED AND SIXTY FOUR MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED AND NINETY ONE THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND SEVENTY NAIRA) ONLY OF WHICH 10 The Sum Of N45,961,784,503 (Forty Five Billion, Nine Hundred and 11 SIXTY ONE MILLION, SEVEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY FOUR THOUSAND, 12 FIVE HUNDRED AND THREE NAIRA ONLY, IS FOR PERSONNEL COSTS AND 13 THE SUM OF N33,834,186,423 (THIRTY THREE BILLION, EIGHT HUNDRED 14 AND THIRTY FOUR MILLION, ONE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SIX THOUSAND, 15 FOUR HUNDRED AND TWENTY THREE NAIRA) ONLY IS FOR OVERHEAD 16 COSTS WHILST THE BALANCE OF N114,068, 620, 544 (ONE HUNDRED AND 17 FOURTEEN BILLION, SIXTY-EIGHT MILLION, SIX HUNDRED AND TWENTY 18 THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED AND FORTY-FOUR NAIRA) ONLY IS FOR 19 CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR THE SERVICE OF THE FEDERAL CAPITAL 20 TERRITORY, ABUJA, FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR COMMENCING FROM 1ST 21 JANUARY 2015 AND ENDING ON 31ST MARCH, 2016." 22
