Section 2(6) of the Principal Act is amended by striking out the Striking out section 2(6) subsection for being repetitive of section 1(3) of the Principal Act. 7 4. Section 2(7) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the Amendment of Section 2(7) O word "Public" in line 2 before the word "Corporations". 5. Section 6 of the Principal Act is amended by striking out the 10 Amendment of Section 6 11 semi column in section 6(a) and insert after the words, "Public Institution" in line 2 the following; or consultation are necessary to comply with the 12 application that cannot reasonably be completed within the original time 13 limit". 14 And introduce section 6(b) thus: 15 "b" the Public Institution must give notice of the extension stating whether 16 the extension falls under the circumstance set out in this Section, which 17 notice shall contain a statement that the application has a right to have the 18 decision to extend the limit reviewed by the Court. 19
