This Bill seeks to alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 (as altered) to balance annual budgetary allocation of resources between recurrent and capital expenditure, to place local government councils on first line charge, to abolish state and local government joint account and State Independent Electoral Commission and transfer its jurisdiction to Independent National Electoral Commission.
