5 subject to the same process as if issued upon a notice.

6 *Certificate of Compliance*

7 (ed) The Corps shall issue a Certificate of Compliance to any person  
8 (natural or corporate) evidencing compliance with a notice served on such  
9 person requiring compliance by the installation and maintenance of closed  
10 circuit television in respect of any premises or location designated a 'high risk  
11 public place'.

12 *Fees and Regulations*

13 (ef) Fees as may be specified in regulation made under this Act shall  
14 be chargeable for carrying out any reviews or assessment of any premises or  
15 location in respect of which a 'high risk public place' notice has been issued.

16 *Notices*

17 (eg) A notice issued on any person (whether natural or corporate) in  
18 respect of any premises or location under its control and management and  
19 designated as a 'high risk public place', may require in addition to compliance  
20 with the notice to install and maintain a closed circuit television, to maintain  
21 continuous CCTV recording of the place which shall be archived for not less  
22 than 6 months and presented on request in a format stipulated in the notice.

This Bill seeks to provide guidance for the enforcement of security measures through the requirement for the installation and management of closed circuit television (CCTV) in any public or private premises or location designated 'a high public place'.
