Edward Gyang Pwajok I Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria: 1 The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999, as altered is 2 altered as set out hereunder. 1. The concurrent Legislative list is altered by inserting a new item 3 4 21 as follows: "The National Assembly may make laws for the Federation or any part 5 thereof with respect to investigation into any matter within its Legislative 6 competence, including the establishment of agencies, institutes bodies to 7 carry out investigations, including the training, supervision and 8 9 qualification of such persons". (a) Nothing in the foregoing paragraphs of this item shall be 10 construed as precluding a House of Assembly from making laws with 11 respect to any item referred to in the foregoing paragraphs. 12 2. The other items on the concurrent list are renumbered 13 14 accordingly. 15 3. This Bill may be cited as the Constitution of the Federal Citation Republic of Nigeria (Alteration) Bill, 2016. 16 **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM** This Bill seeks to alter the Constitution to provide for a Legal Framework that will allow investigations even agencies who may be outside the

recognized Security Agencies and this may even include Private Investigators.
