BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal
Republic of Nigeria as follows:

1 1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999 is
2 hereby altered as set out hereunder.

3 2. The Principal Act is hereby altered in section 233 (2) and section
4 6 of the 2nd alteration Act, by adding a new sub-section vii as follows:
5 (vii) Whether any person has been validly elected to the office of
6 Senator or Member House of Representatives under this Constitution.

7 3. This Bill may be cited as the Constitution of the Federal
8 Republic of Nigeria 1999 (Alteration) Bill, 2016.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to further alter the Constitution of the Federal Republic of
Nigeria, 1999 [second Alteration] Act 2010, to provide for appeals in respect
of election of Senators and Members of House of Representatives to be
finally determined by the Supreme Court.
