Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1.-(1) There is hereby established the National Cancer Institute (in Establishment this Act referred to as "the Institute"). of the Institute The Institute shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession; and a common seal and may sue or be sued in its corporate 4 name. 6 (3) The Institute shall be located in the Federal Capital Territory of Nigeria and may establish Zonal Centres at the Six Geo-political Zones of 8 the country. 9 (4) The Institute shall affiliate itself with leading cancer research 10 institute all over the world as may be determined by the Minister. 11 2.-(1) The functions of the Institute shall be to Functions of the Institute 12 (a) co-ordinate a national research programme on causes, 13 prevention, detection, diagnosis and treatment of Cancer through various 14 research projects and clinical trials; and 15 (b) any other function as may be determined by the Panel of the 16 Institute from time to time. 17 3.
