AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTORAL ACT 2010 TO AMONG OTHER THINGS MAKE OUR ELECTORAL PROCESS FULL PROVE, BY MAKING THE CARD READER THE CREDIBLE MEANS OF VOTERS ACCREDITATION AND VOTING AND PROVIDE FOR STRICT COMPLIANCE TO ELECTION GUIDE LINES AND MANUAL SO AS TO ENHANCE TRANSPARENCY AND EFFICIENCY IN THE CONDUCT OF FREE, FAIR AND CREDIBLE ELECTIONS AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

The Electoral Act 2010 (in this bill referred to as "the Principal Amendment of the Principal Act Act") is amended as set out in this Bill. 2.
