AN ACT TO ALTER THE CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA 1999 TO EXPRESSLY EMPOWER THE INDEPENDENT NATIONAL ELECTORAL COMMISSION TO CONDUCT FRESH ELECTION WHERE THE CANDIDATE WITH THE HIGHEST VOTES DIES WHILE THE ELECTION IS ON-GOING OR BEFORE THE DECLARATION OF THE FINAL RESULT OF THE ELECTION BY THE INDEPENDENT NATIONAL ELECTORAL COMMISSION

ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows:

- 1 **1.** The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria 1999
 2 (hereinafter referred as “the Constitution”) is amended as set out below:
 3 (a) In Section 136, after the existing subsection (2) insert a new
 4 subsection thus:
 5 “(3) Where a Candidate adjudged by the Independent National
 6 Electoral Commission to have majority of lawful votes cast dies before the
 7 declaration of the final result of the election, the Independent National
 8 Electoral Commission shall conduct fresh election.”

 10 subsection thus:
 11 “(3) Where a Candidate adjudged by the Independent National
