AN ACT TO AMEND 1999 CONSTITUTION OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF NIGERIA TO ENHANCE POLITICAL INCLUSION AND PARTICIPATION OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN GOVERNANCE IN NIGERIA

## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria to enhance political inclusion and participation of young people in governance.
