AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE FOR ARID RESEARCH AND DESERTIFICATION CONTROL AND TO MAKE FOR COMPREHENSIVE PROVISION FOR IT'S MANAGEMENT ADMINISTRATION AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Ahmed Babba Kaita Commencement BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1.-(1) There is hereby established the National Institute for Arid Establishment of 1 the National Institute for Arid Research and Desertification Control (here referred to as "the institute") 2 Research Desertification which shall be situated in Abuja the Federal Capital Territory. 5	SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE BOARD	
6	1. Subject to this Act and section 27 of the interpretation Act	
7	(which provides for decision of a statutory body to be taken by a majority of	
8	it's members and for the person presiding at any meeting when a vote is	
9	ordered to have a' second or casting vote); the Board may make standing	
10	order to regulate it's proceedings and meetings.	
11	2. At every meeting of the Board the chairman shall preside and in	
12	his absence the members present shall appoint one of their member to

14	3. Four times each year and subject to the decision of members the	
15	Board shall meet whenever it summoned the chairman and if required to do

18	4. Where the Board desires to obtain the advice of an expert on a	
19	particular matter, the Board may co-opt him for the period which his time is
