Nigeria as follows: 1. The Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria hereinafter 1 referred to as lithe Principal Act" is amended as set out in this Act. 2 2. Section 147(1) of the Principal Act is substituted with a new 3 section 147(1)-"147(1)- There shall be established the following Ministries in the 5 Government of the Federation to which the President shall appoint 6 Ministers: 7 (a) Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development; 8 (b) Ministry of Commerce; 9 (c) Ministry of Culture and Tourism; 10 (d) Ministry of Defence; 11 (e) Ministry of Education, Science and Technology; 12 (f) Ministry of Environment and Water Resources; 13 (g) Ministry of Finance; 14 (h) Ministry of Foreign Affairs; 15 (i) Ministry of Health; 16 (i) Ministry of Information and Communication; 17 (k) Ministry of Interior; 18 (I) Ministry of Justice; 19 (m) Ministry of Labour;
