Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1 1. The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria Act Cap. A26 Amendment of Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 (in this bill referred to as the Cap. 111 LFN, 2 3 "Principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill. 4 2. Section 12 (5) is amended by substituting for the words, "Court Amendment of Section 12 (5) 5 of Appeal" in lines 3, the words "High Court". 6 Section 18 (5) (a) of the Principal Act is amended by Amendment of Section 18 (5) (a) substituting for the expression, N100.00 the expression "N100,000.00". 7 Section 18 (5) (b) of the Principal Act is amended by 8 Amendment of Section 18 (5) (b) 9 substituting for the expression N1,000.00 the expression "N500,000.00". 10 5. This Bill may be cited as the Institute of Chartered Accountants Citation 11 of Nigeria (Amendment) Bill, 2016. EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM This Bill seeks to amend the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria Act Cap. 111 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to increase the fines and to make appeal lie from the Disciplinary Tribunal to the High Court.
