AN ACT TO AMEND THE ELECTRIC POWER SECTOR REFORM ACT, CAP. E7 LFN 2004 TO REPOSITION THE NIGERIAN ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION FOR EFFECTIVE SERVICE DELIVERY; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

MATTERS Sponsored by Hon. Muhammad Usman Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Electric Power Sector Reform Act, CAP. E7 LFN, 2004 Amendment of (herein referred to as "the principal Act") is amended as set out in this Bill. 2 Electric Power Sector Reform 3 2. Section 32(3) of the Principal Act is amended by inserting the Act Amendment of phrase, "the representative of the labour unions', immediately after the word 4 Section 32 5 'investors' 6 3. Section 56(5) of the principal Act, is amended by substituting Amendment of the existing provisions, a new provision as follows: 7 Section 56 "(5) Notwithstanding the provision of sub-section (4) of this 9 section, whether or not the Minister authorizes, the Commission shall 10 publish its audited statement of account in two national newspapers within 11 one month following the receipt of the auditor's report under sub section (3) 12 of this section, and the Commission shall thereafter publish the statement of 13 account in the manner as stated in the Act." 14 4. Section 57(2) of the principal Act is amended by substituting for Amendment of 15 the words "twenty thousand", the words "five hundred thousand". Section 57 16 5. Section 60(2) of the Principal Act is amended by substituting the Amendment of existing provision, a new provision thus: "The Commission in fixing the 17 Section 60 remuneration, allowances and pension benefits of the staff of the 18

Commission, shall take into consideration such conditions of service as

applicable in the civil service of the Federation and other similar Commissions 1 of the government of the Federation". 2 6. Section 67 (1) of the Principal Act is amended by introducing new 3 Amendment of Section 67 subsection (1) (d) to read thus: "(d) the license shall also state the right of electricity consumers or 5 consumers association of a distribution company to either complain to the commission or to sue the distribution company." 7 7. Section 88(13) of the Principal Act is amended by introducing new 8 Amendment of Section 88 subsection (13)(e) to read thus: g. "(e) any contravention of the provision of subsection (13) (d) of this section by any official of the Agency, shall on conviction be liable to 11 imprisonment for a term of one year or a fine not exceeding five hundred 12 thousand naira or both." 13 8. This Bill may be cited as the Electric Power Sector Reform Act 14 Short Title (Amendment) Bill, 2016. 15

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill seeks to amend the Electric Power Sector Reform Act, CAP. E7 LFN, 2004 to enable the Nigerian Electricity Regulatory Commission carry out its statutory mandates for greater output of electricity generation and distribution in Nigeria.
