AN ACT TO AMEND THE ENERGY COMMISSION OF NIGERIA ACT, CAP, E10 LFN, 2004 TO GRANT PRIORITY TO THE PROMOTION AND DEVELOPMENT OF RENEWAL ENERGY IN NIGERIA; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Sponsored by Hon. Muhammad Usman Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Energy Commission of Nigeria Act cap. Section 8(1) of the principal Act is amended by introducing the 15 Amendment of Section 8 following: 16 (a) There is further established Renewable Energy Fund: 17 (i) The fund shall be as appropriated by the National Assembly; 18 (ii) by way of donations, grants and gift - in -aid received for 19 renewable energy activities.

1 (iii) renewable energy tax levied on multinational companies; and 2 (iv) such other moneys generated by the Commission from the 3 provision of services for renewable energy; Insertion of a 4. The Principal Act is amended by introducing new section 9 and the new section 5 existing sections 9-10 are re-numbered accordingly. "9 (1) An electricity distribution utility bulk customer shall procure a 6 Renewable energy purchase obligation 7 specific percentage of its total purchase of electricity from renewable energy 8 source. 9 (2) The National Electricity Regulatory commission shall, in 10 Consultation with Energy Commission of Nigeria specify the percentage level 11 of electricity to be purchased by the electricity utility or bulk customer." 12 5. This Bill may be cited as the Energy Commission of Nigeria Act Short title (Amendment) Bill, 2016. 13

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill seeks to amend the Energy Commission of Nigeria, Act to confer additional powers on the commission to accord priority to the promotion and development of alternative and renewable sources of energy in order to facilitate the growth of energy supply in Nigeria.
