## **ABILL**

## FOR

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT, CAP.C4S, LAWS OF THE FEDERATION OF NIGERIA, 2004; AND FOR RELATED MATTERS, 2016

Sponsored by Hon. Akpatason Ohiozojeh Peter Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows: 1. The Custom and Excise Management Act, Cap. C 45, Laws of Amendment of Cap. C45 LFN, the Federation of Nigeria 2004, (herein after referred to as the Principal Act) 2004 is amended as set in this Bill. 2. Section 24 of the Principal Act is amended by introducing new Amendment of Section 24 section 24 sub sections (2-3), and the existing Section 24 becomes sub-6 section (1). (2) The Order shall include: 8 (a) Preventing the conveyance of any prohibited goods into the 9 Nigeria market; 10 (b) Prosecute any seller, whose warehouse displays, sell and or 11 issue receipt in respect of such prohibited goods. 12 (3) the buyer of any of the Prohibited goods shall be entitled to a 13 refund of his money or retain the goods in question and shall not be 14 prosecuted thereof, where it is established that the buyer bought the goods in 15 an open market; provided that the unsuspecting buyer revealed the identify 16 of his supplier. 17 3. This Bill may be cited as the Customs and Excise Management 18 Short title Act (Amendment) Bill, 2016. 19

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill seeks to amend the Customs and Excise Management Act to protect an unsuspecting buyer of any prohibited goods Imported in to Nigeria, provided the goods were sold in an Open Market, and to ensure that importers of such goods are made to pay the prize.
