AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE FCT INTEGRATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

Sponsored by Hon. Zaphaniah Jisalo

[] Commencement

BE IT ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria as follows-

1 1.-(1) There is hereby established a body to be known as the FCT
2 Integration and Development Commission (in this Act referred to as "the
3 Commission").

Establishment of

4 (2) The Commission-
5 (a) shall be a body corporate with perpetual succession and a
6 common seal;

7 (b) may sue and be sued in its corporate name.

8 (3) The Commission shall have its head office in the Federal
9 Capital Territory, Abuja.

10 2. The Commission shall consist of-

Establishment of

11 (a) Chairman;

12 (b) two persons representing public interest in the Federal Capital
13 Territory who shall be persons with cognate experience in Town Planning
14 and Civil Engineering;

15 (c) one person representing each of the Six Area Councils of the
16 Federal Capital Territory as follows-

17 (i) Abaji Area Council;

18 (ii) Abuja Area Municipal Council;

19 (iii) Bwari Area Council;

20 (iv) Gwagwalada Area Council;

21 (v) K wali Area Council; and

1 (vi) Kujc Area Council.

2 (d) one person to represent the Agriculture and Rural Development
3 Secretariat of the FCDA;

4 (e) one person to represent the Engineering Department of the FCDA;

5 (f) one person representing the Department of Regional Planning
6 Land and Survey of FCDA;

7 (g) The Executive Secretary/Chief Executive Officer shall be the
8 secretary to the Commission.

9 (2) The Chairman and other members of the Council shall-

10 (a) be appointed by the Minister;

11 (b) be persons of proven integrity and ability.

12 (3) The members of the Commission referred to in paragraph (a) - (f)
13 of subsection (2) of this section shall be part-time members.

Tenure of Office
of Members

14 3.-(1) Subject to the provisions of section 4 of this Act a member of
15 the Commission, other than an ex-officio member, shall hold office for a term
16 of 4 years at the first instance and may be reappointed for a further term of 4
17 years and no more.

18 (2) A member of the Commission other than ex-officio member, may
19 resign his appointment by notice, in writing under his hand addressed to the
20 Minister of the Federal Capital Territory

Removal /
Cessation from
Office

21 4.-(1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 3 of this Act, a
22 person shall cease to hold office as a member of the Commission if-

23 (a) he becomes bankrupt, suspends payment or compounds with his
24 creditors;

25 (b) he is convicted of a felony or any offence involving dishonesty or
26 fraud,

27 (c) he becomes of unsound mind, or incapable of carrying out his
28 duties;

29 (d) he is guilty of a serious misconduct in relation to his duties;

30 (e) in the case of a person who possessed a professional qualifications,

1 he is disqualified or suspended, other than at his own request, from
2 practicing his profession in any part of the world by an order of a competent
3 authority made in respect of that member: or

4 (f) he resigns his appointment by a letter addressed to the Minister
5 of the Federal Capital Territory.

6 (3) Where a vacancy occurs in the membership of the Commission
7 it shall be filled by the appointment of a successor to hold office for the
8 remainder of the term of office of his predecessor, so however, that the
9 successor shall represent the same interest and shall be appointed by the
10 Minister.

11 5. There shall be paid to every Commission member and staff of
12 the Commission such remunerations, allowances and expenses as the
13 Federal Government may, from time to time, direct.

Remuneration
of Members

14 6.-(1) The Commission shall-

Functions and
powers of the
Commission, etc.

15 (a) formulate policies and guidelines on the proper Resettlement
16 and Integration of the FCT Aborigines;

17 (b) conceive, plan and implement, in accordance with set rules and
18 regulations, projects and programmes of the FCT Aborigines in the areas of
19 Agriculture, Education, Scholarship, Health and Environment

20 (c) implement all the measures approved for the development of
21 the rural and satellite areas by the Federal Government and the Commission;

22 (d) identify factors inhibiting the development of such areas and
23 assist in the formulation and implementation of policies to ensure sound and
24 efficient management of the resources of the Commission;

25 (e) ensure effective planning, projects assessment, proper
26 resettlement and integration of FCT aborigines, economic and social
27 development of the people; if) assess and report on any projects being
28 funded or carried out by the Commission, Federal Government, FCT
29 Administration and the Private Sector including non-governmental

1 organizations and ensure that funds released for such projects are properly
2 utilized;

3 (g) execute such other works and perform such other functions which
4 in the opinion of the Commission, are required for the sustainable all round
5 development of the rural areas and its peoples; and

6 (2) In exercising its functions and powers under this section, the
7 Commission shall have regard to the varied and specific contributions of the
8 Federal Capital Administration.

9 (3) The Commission shall be subject to the direction, control or
10 supervision in the performance of its functions under this Act by the Minister of
11 FCT.

Structure of the
Commission

12 7. There shall be established in the head office of the Commission, the
13 following Departments:

14 (a) the Department of Finance, Administration, and Integration;

15 (b) the Department of Engineering, Re-Settlement and Project
16 Monitoring;

17 (c) the Department of Regional Planning and Survey;

18 (d) the Department of Social Services and Research and Information.

19 (2) The Commission may with the approval of the FCT Minister
20 increase the number of directorates as it may deem necessary and expedient to
21 facilitate the realization of the objectives of the Commission.

Establishment
of the Management
Committee

22 8. There shall be for the Commission a Management Committee
23 which shall:

24 (a) consist of a Chairman who shall be the Chief Executive Officer,
25 the Directors responsible for the Department established under section 7 of this
26 Act and such number of other members as may be determined from time to time
27 by the Commission;

28 (b) be responsible to the Commission for the general administration
29 of the Commission.

1 9.-(1) There shall be for the Commission, an Executive
2 Secretary/Chief Executive Officer, and Director of the Departments
3 established in Section 7 of this Act:

Staff and other
employees of the
Commission

4 (a) have such qualification and experience as are appropriate for a
5 person required to perform the functions of those offices under this Act;

6 (b) the Minister shall appoint the Executive Secretary, Chief
7 Executive Officer of the Commission who shall be the accounting officer;
8 and

9 (c) hold office on such terms and conditions as to emolument,
10 conditions of service as may be specified in his letter of appointment, and
11 subject to the provision of section 3 of this Act.

12 (2) The Secretary shall, subject to the general direction of the
13 Commission, be responsible:

14 (a) for the day to day administration of the Commission;

15 (b) for keeping the books and Proper records of the proceedings of
16 the Commission;

17 (c) the administration of the secretariat of the Commission; and

18 (d) the general direction and control of all other employees of the
19 Commission.

20 (3) The Commission shall have power to employ either directly or
21 on secondment from any civil or public service in the Federation or a State
22 such number of employees as may be in the opinion of the Commission, be
23 required to assist the Commission in the discharge of any of its functions
24 under this Act.

25 10.-(1) Service in the Commission shall be approved service in line
26 with the provisions of the Contributory Pensions Reform Act, 2004.

Application of
Pensions Reforms
Act, 2004

27 (2) The officers and other persons employed into the Commission
28 shall be entitled to pensions, gratuities and other retirement benefits as are
29 enjoyed by persons holding equivalent grades as appropriate.

30 (3) Nothing in subsections (1) and (2) of this section shall prevent

1 the appointment of a person to any office on terms which preclude the grant of
2 pension and gratuity in respect of that office authority of the Government of the
3 Federation, other than the power to make regulations under section 23 thereof
4 is hereby vested in and shall be exercisable by the Commission, and not by any
5 other person or authority.

Financial
Provisions

6 11.-(1) The Commission shall establish and maintain a fund from
7 which shall be defrayed all expenditure incurred by the Commission.

8 (2) There shall be paid and credited to the fund established pursuant to
9 subsection (1) of this section-

10 (a) Budgetary provision from Federal Capital Development
11 Authority and the Federal Capital Territory Administration;

12 (b) 5% of all monies accrued to FCTA as charges from the allocation
13 of plots of land in FCT;

14 (c) such monies as may from time to time be granted or lent the
15 Commission;

16 (d) all moneys raised for the purposes of the Commission by way of
17 gifts, loan, grants-in-aid, testamentary disposition or otherwise;

18 (e) proceeds from all other assets that may, from time to time, accrue
19 to the Commission.

20 (f) specifying the manner in which the assets or the fund of the
21 Commission are to be held, and regulating the making of payments into and
22 out of the fund; and

23 (g) requiring the keeping of proper accounts and records for the
24 purpose of the fund in such form as may be specified in the rules.

Expenditure of
the Commission

25 12. The Commission shall apply the proceeds of the fund established
26 pursuant to section 14 of this Act to:

27 (a) the cost of administration of the Commission;

28 (b) the payment of salaries, fees, remuneration, allowances, pensions
29 and gratuities payable to the members of the Commission specified in section 6

1 of this Act or any committee of the Commission and the employees of the
2 Commission;

3 (c) the payment for all contracts, including mobilization,
4 fluctuations, variations, legal fees and cost on contract administration;

5 (d) the payment for all purchases; and

6 (e) undertaking such other activities as are connected with all or
7 any of the Functions of the Commission under this Act.

8 **13.-(1)** The Commission may accept gifts of land, money, or other
9 property on such terms and conditions, if any, as may be specified by the
10 person or organization making the gift.

Power to accept
Gifts

11 (2) The Commission shall not accept any gift if the conditions
12 attached by the person or organization making the gift are inconsistent with,
13 the functions of the Commission under this Act.

14 **14.** The Commission may, with the consent of the Minister,
15 borrow, on such terms and conditions as the Commission may determine,
16 such sums of money as the Commission may require in the exercise of its
17 functions under this Act.

Power to borrow

18 **15.-(1)** The Commission shall submit to the Minister of FCT its
19 annual Budget for the succeeding year for consideration.

Submission of
Annual Budget

20 (2) The Commission shall be cause to be kept proper accounts of
21 the Commission in respect of each year and proper records in relation
22 thereto and shall cause the accounts to be audited not later than 6 months
23 after the end of each year by auditors appointed from the list and in
24 accordance with the guidelines supplied by the Auditor-General for the
25 Federation.

26 **16.** The Commission shall, at the end of every quarter in each year,
27 submit to the Minister of the Federal Capital Territory report on the activities
28 and administration of the Commission.

Annual Report

29 **17.-(1)** The Commission shall prepare and submit to the Minister of
30 the Federal Capital Territory, not later than 30th June in each year, a report in

Audit Report

1 such form as the FCT Minister may direct on the activities of the Commission
2 during the immediately preceding year, and shall include in the report a copy of
3 the audited accounts of the Commission for that year and the auditor's report
4 thereon.

5 (2) The Minister shall, upon receipt of the report referred to in
6 subsection (1) of this section, cause a copy of the report and the audited
7 accounts of the Commission and the auditor's report thereon to be submitted to
8 each House of the National Assembly.

Office premises
of the Commission

9 18. For the purposes of providing offices and premises necessary for
10 the performance of its functions under this Act, the Commission may, subject
11 to the Land Use Act:

12 (a) purchase or take on lease any interest in land, or other property;
13 and

14 (b) construct offices and premises and equip and maintain same.

15 (2) The Commission may, subject to the Land Use Act, sell or lease
16 out any office or premises held by it, which office or premises is no longer
17 required for the performance of its functions under this Act.

Directives

18 19.-(1) Subject to the provisions of this Act, the provisions of the
19 Public Officers Protection Act shall apply in relation to any suit instituted
20 against any officer or employee of the Commission.

21 (2) Notwithstanding anything contained in any other law or
22 enactment, no suit shall lie against any member of the Council, the Executive
23 Secretary or any other officer or employee of the Commission for any act done
24 in pursuance or execution of this Act or any other law or enactment, or of any
25 public duty or authority or in respect of any alleged neglect or default in the
26 execution of this Act or such law or enactment, duty or authority, shall lie or be
27 instituted in any court unless-

28 (a) it is commenced within three months next after the act, neglect or
29 default complained of; or

30 (b) in the case of a continuation of damage or injury, within six

1 months next after the ceasing thereof.

2 20. A notice, summons or other document required or authorized
3 to be served upon the Commission under the provisions of this Act or any
4 other law or enactment may be served by delivering it to the Executive
5 Secretary or by sending it by registered post and addressed to the Executive
6 Secretary as the principal officer of the Commission.

Service of
document

7 21.-(1) In any action or suit against the Commission, no execution
8 or attachment of process in the nature thereof shall be issued against the
9 Commission.

Limitation of
suits against the
Commission

10 (2) Any sum of money which may by the judgment of any court be
11 awarded against the Commission shall, subject to any direction given by
12 court where notice of appeal of the said judgment has been given, be paid
13 from the general reserve fund of the Commission.

14 22. A member of the Commission, the Executive Secretary, any
15 officer or employee of the Commission shall be indemnified out of the assets
16 of the Commission against any proceeding, whether civil or criminal, in
17 which judgment is given in his favour or in which he is acquitted, if any such
18 proceeding is brought against him in his capacity as a member of the
19 Commission, the Executive Secretary, officer or employee of the
20 Commission.

Indemnity of
staff

21 23. The Commission may, with the approval of the Minister, make
22 regulations, generally for the purposes of giving full effect to this Act. From
23 the commencement of this Act, the Unit of Resettlement, and Integration of
24 the Federal Capital Development Authority stands scrapped and its
25 functions subsumed into the FCT Integration and Development
26 Commission established by this Act.

Power to make
regulations

27 24. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires-

28 "Chairman" means the Chairman of the Commission;

29 "Commission" means the FCT Integration and Development Commission
30 established by section 1 of this Act;

Interpretation

1 "Member" means a member of the Commission and includes the Chairman,
2 and other Members of the Commission;

Citation

3 25. This Bill may be cited as the FCT Integration and Development
4 Commission (Establishment, etc.) Bill, 2016.

7 SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE COMMISSION, ETC.

8 *Proceedings of the Commission*

9 1.-(1) Subject to this Act and section 27 of the Interpretation Act, the
10 Council may make standing orders regulating its proceedings or those of any of
11 its committees.

12 (2) The quorum of the Commission shall be the Chairman the person
13 presiding at the meeting, Executive Secretary and one third of other members
14 of the Commission. The quorum of any Committee of the Commission shall be
15 as determined by the Commission.

16 2.-(1) The Commission shall meet whenever it is summoned by the
17 Chairman and if the Chairman is required to do so by notice given to him by not
18 less than 4 other members, he shall summon a meeting of the Commission to be
19 held within 14 days from the date on which the notice is given.

20 (2) At any meeting of the Commission the Chairman shall preside but
21 if he is absent, the members present at the meeting shall appoint one of their
22 members to preside at the meeting.

23 3.-(1) The Commission may appoint one or more committees to carry
24 out, on behalf of the Commission such functions as the Commission may
25 determine.

26 (2) A committee appointed under this paragraph shall consist of such
27 number of persons as may be determined by the Commission and a person shall
28 hold office on the committee in accordance with the terms of his appointment.

29 (3) A decision of a committee of the Commission shall be of no effect
30 until it is confirmed by the Commission.

1 4.-(1) The fixing of the seal of the Commission shall be
2 authenticated by the signatures of the Chairman or any other member of the
3 Commission generally or specifically authorized by the Commission to act
4 for that purpose and the Executive Secretary.

5 (2) A document purporting to be a document duly executed under
6 the seal of the Commission shall be received in evidence and shall, unless
7 and until the contrary is proved be presumed to be so executed.

8 5. The validity of any proceedings of the Commission or of a
9 committee shall not be adversely affected by:

10 (a) a vacancy in the membership of the Commission or committee;

11 (b) a defect in the appointment of a member of the Commission or
12 committee; or

13 (c) reason that a person not entitled to do so took part in the
14 proceedings of the Commission or committee.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to provide for the establishment of the FCT Integration and Development Commission which shall be responsible for formulating policies and guidelines for the proper Integration and development of the FCT aborigines; conceiving, planning and implementing, in accordance with set rules and regulations, projects and programmes for the sustainable development of the rural areas of the FCT, rural industrialization, agriculture and water supply; causing the rural areas to be surveyed in order to ascertain measures which are necessary to promote its agricultural and socio-economic development; preparing master plans and schemes designed to promote the physical development of the areas and the estimates of the costs of implementing such master plans and schemes; implementing all the measures approved for the development of the rural areas by the FCTA; identifying factors inhibiting the proper resettlement of such areas and assist in the formulation and implementation of policies to ensure sound and efficient management of the resources of the Commission.
