## **ABILL**

### **FOR**

AN ACT TO REPEAL MONITORING OF REVENUE ALLOCATION TO LOCAL GOVERNMENTS ACT 2005 AND ENACT THE MONITORING OF REVENUE ALLOCATION TO AREA COUNCILS APPLICABLE TO THE FEDERAL CAPITAL TERRITORY ONLY AND FOR RELATED MATTERS

ALLOCATION TO AREA COUNCILS APPLICABLE TO THE FEDERAL CAPITAL TERRITORY ONLY AND FOR RELATED MATTERS Sponsored by Hon. Dennis J. Agbo ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria-1. There is hereby established a Federal Capital Territory Joint Establishment of Joint Area Councils Account Allocation Area Councils Account Allocation Committee, which shall comprise the Committee for the FCT following members-(a) the Permanent Secretary of the Federal Capital Territory who 4 shall be the Chairman: (b) a Commissioner of Revenue Mobilisation, Allocation and 6 Fiscal Commission, provided that the Commissioner is not from the Federal Capital Territory; 8 (c) the Chairman of each Area Council in the Federal Capital Territory: 10 (d) one representative of the Accountant-General of the 11 Federation; 12 (e) the Director in charge of finance; and 13 (f) a Director in the Federal Capital Territory to be appointed by 14 the Minister in charge of the Federal Capital Territory who shall be the 15 Secretary of the Committee. 16 2. The functions of the Federal Capital Territory Joint Area 17 Functions of the Joint Area Councils Allocation: Councils Allocation Committee shall be to ensure that any allocation made 18 Committee to the Area Councils in the Federal Capital Territory from the Federation 19

Account and from the Federal Capital Territory are promptly paid into the Federal Capital Territory Joint Area Councils Account and distributed to the Area Councils in accordance with the provisions of any Act made in that behalf by the National Assembly. 3. The power of the Federal Capital Territory for borrowing money Limits on the power of the FCT for borrowing shall not extend to the money, funds or revenue allocated to Area Councils from 6 money ' the Federation Account, and from the Federal Capital Territory. 4. -(1) It shall be unlawful for any organ, authority or official of the Limits of power 9 to deduct or re-allocate any Federal Capital Territory, however described or constituted, to alter, deduct or 10 amount standing to the credit of re-allocate fundsstanding to the credit of the Federal Capital Territory Joint 11 FCT Area Councils Joint Accounts, etc. 12 Area Councils Account: Provided always that nothing in this subsection shall prevent the National 13 Assembly, from prescribing by law the terms and manner for distributing 14 money standing to the credit of the Joint the Area Councils Accounts in the 15 Federal Capital Territory. 16 17 (2) Any person who acts in contravention of the provisions of subsection (1) of this section, commits an offence and is liable on conviction to 18 a fine twice the amount altered, deducted or re-allocated illegally, or 19 imprisonment for a term of five years, or to both such fine and imprisonment. 20 5. The Accountant-General of the Federation shall report to each 21 Report by the Accountant General of the House of the National Assembly on a quarterly basis the payments made to the 22 Federation 23 Federal Capital Territory for the benefit of the Area Councils, and stating whether or not the payments were correctly made under this Bill. 24 6. The Auditor-General for the Federation shall following the end of 25 Report by the Auditor-General of the Federation each financial year report to each House of the National Assembly, stating how 26 the monies allocated for the benefit of the Area Councils in the Federal Capital 27 28 Territory were spent. Repeal 7. The Monitoring of Revenue Allocation to Local Governments Act, 29 2005 is hereby repealed. 30
