Commencement ENACTED by the National Assembly of the Federal Republic of Nigeria: 1. The Export (Prohibition) Act Cap. E22 Laws of the Federation Repeal of Cap. E22 LFN, 2004 of Nigeria, 2004 (in this Bill referred to as the "Principal Act") is repealed. 2. This Bill may be cited as the Export (Prohibition) (Repeal) Bill, Citation 2016.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to repeal the Export (Prohibition) Act Cap. E22 Laws of the Federation of Nigeria, 2004 to remove the restrictions placed on exportation of agricultural produce from Nigeria, so as to boost diversification of the Nigerian economy.
