EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to make provision for the prohibition of stigmatisation of persons who are victims of Insurgency or militancy from re-integration with the community and to provide for the prosecution and punishment of any person or group of persons who stigmatise such victims with the view to uphold and protect their Fundamental Right to Dignity and free Association as provided by the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.
